

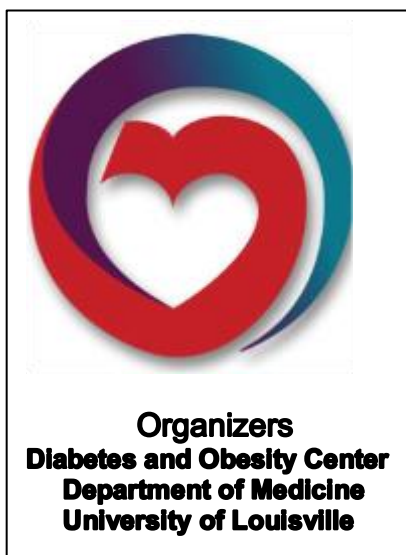

Call for Abstracts

Abstracts are invited from established investigators, postdoctoral fellows and graduate students. The work presented in the abstract must not have been published. All accepted abstracts will be scheduled either for oral or a poster presentation. The presentations will be conducted in English.

Abstract Submission Process and Deadlines

Deadline for abstracts to be published and presented at the meeting is April 10th, 2017.

The last date to withdraw abstract is April 20th, 2017.

Abstracts are to be submitted as part of online registration process. If you are not submitting an abstract, you can still register to attend the meeting.

Format of abstract.

Word limit of abstract is 250 excluding the title, authors and affiliations.

On separate lines, include

- a Title
- b author names
- c affiliations
- d abstract body

Notification of Abstract Acceptance

Authors will receive the notice of acceptance or rejection for their abstracts via email no later than May 1st, 2017.

Oral Presentations

Speakers are allocated approx. 25 minutes to present and 5 minutes for discussion.

Poster Presentations

Two poster sessions will be held during the meeting. The presenters are requested to mount their posters 9:00AM on Wednesday 13th September to remain until 5:00 PM. All the figures, title of poster should be easily readable. Materials needed for mounting poster will be available in the poster area.

Travel Grants
