The Congress venue is centrally located in Pisa at the Sala Convegni, Polo Piagge, Università di Pisa, Via Matteotti 11. Pisa is located in Central Italy (Tuscany) and is a beautiful small historic city on the river Arno, close to the Tyrrhenian Sea and of course well known for its famous leaning tower.

The Congress will start on the afternoon of Wednesday 28th with two plenary lectures and will continue on Thursday 29th and Friday 30th with further plenary lectures, short lectures, poster presentations and round table on the most recent issues related to botanicals. The official language is English; no simultaneous translation will be provided. Additional information is available on the Congress website from the end of February 2017

Pisa is easily accessible by car, plane and train. Another option is by sea, arriving at Livorno Port, located 25 km South of Pisa.

- **If you arrive by car:**

From the North, use the "autostrada" (motorway) A12 and exit at "Pisa Centro".

From the North-East (Bologna-Firenze), use the "autostrada" (motorway) A11 and at "Pisa Nord" enter the autostrada A12 and exit at "Pisa Centro".

Alternatively, from Firenze, use the "Firenze-Pisa-Livorno (FI-PI-LI)" dual carriageway (toll-free) and exit at "Pisa Nord Est".

From the South, use the "strada statale" SS1 Aurelia.

Alternatively, use the "autostrada" A1 to Firenze, then "autostrada" A11, and at "Pisa Nord" enter the autostrada A12 and exit at "Pisa Centro".

- **If you arrive by plane:**

Direct flights connect Pisa International Airport "Galileo Galilei" to many Italian and International destinations. The airport is about 1 km from the Congress Centre. A city bus (LAM Rossa) connects the airport to Pisa center every 10 minutes. The bus terminus is located near the arrival site of the airport. Here you can also find the taxi rank. Radio Taxy service telephone: 050/541600. Furthermore, at less than 40 metres from the Passenger Terminal, you will find the new, high-speed, fully automatic People Mover service for direct connections between the Pisa Centrale railway station (in progress). The service will be available every day from 6:00 AM to midnight at 5/8 minute intervals.

- **If you arrive by train:**

Pisa Centrale station is one of the main Italian railway junctions and it is connected to Firenze, Roma, Genova and Lucca by frequent trains.
