RESEARCH INTERESTS

My primary research interests are in political philosophy, especially in normative theories of democracy. Previously I enquired the relationship between sovereignty and representation in the social contract tradition, while, currently, I am working on deliberative and epistemic democratic theories. In particular, my aim is to analyze the epistemic and motivational power of individual interest with regard to the idea of a common good. I frame this question within both normative political theory and political science, by addressing the literature in deliberative and epistemic democracy (Cohen, Estlund, Christiano and others) and in social choice theory (Downs, Arrow and Riker). Moreover I am also interested in the metaethical debate between internalism and externalism of reasons, which I consider fundamental in order to tackle my question.
